

Georgia SoftWorks Releases RF FormMaker

(Dawsonville, GA) — Software developers and programmers take note: mobile software provider Georgia SoftWorks announced RF FormMaker for Windows NT/XP/2000/2003. The product is an ActiveX object that provides a suite of form controls for the Visual Basic.NET developer for creating forms for any device capable of running a telnet or SSH2 (secure shell version 2) client. RF FormMaker is designed to eliminate the low-level work normally required for form and control handling. “With this tool, developers simply declare the controls rather than design them,” says David Sexton, president and CEO of Georgia SoftWorks. “RF FormMaker uses Windows Console APIs [application program interfaces] to create high-level APIs similar to ones available for Windows GUI programs. What you can do in a half-dozen lines using RF FormMaker requires more than 10,000 lines of low-level C code.”

One of the primary benefits of the new product is that it enables form development to take place on the server/workstation rather than on the device. This eliminates the need to work with proprietary development environments for each device. “By having the application on the server, you get the benefits and features of the telnet/SSH2 server such as security, monitoring, broadcasting, access control, and Georgia SoftWorks mobile clients,” says Sexton.
